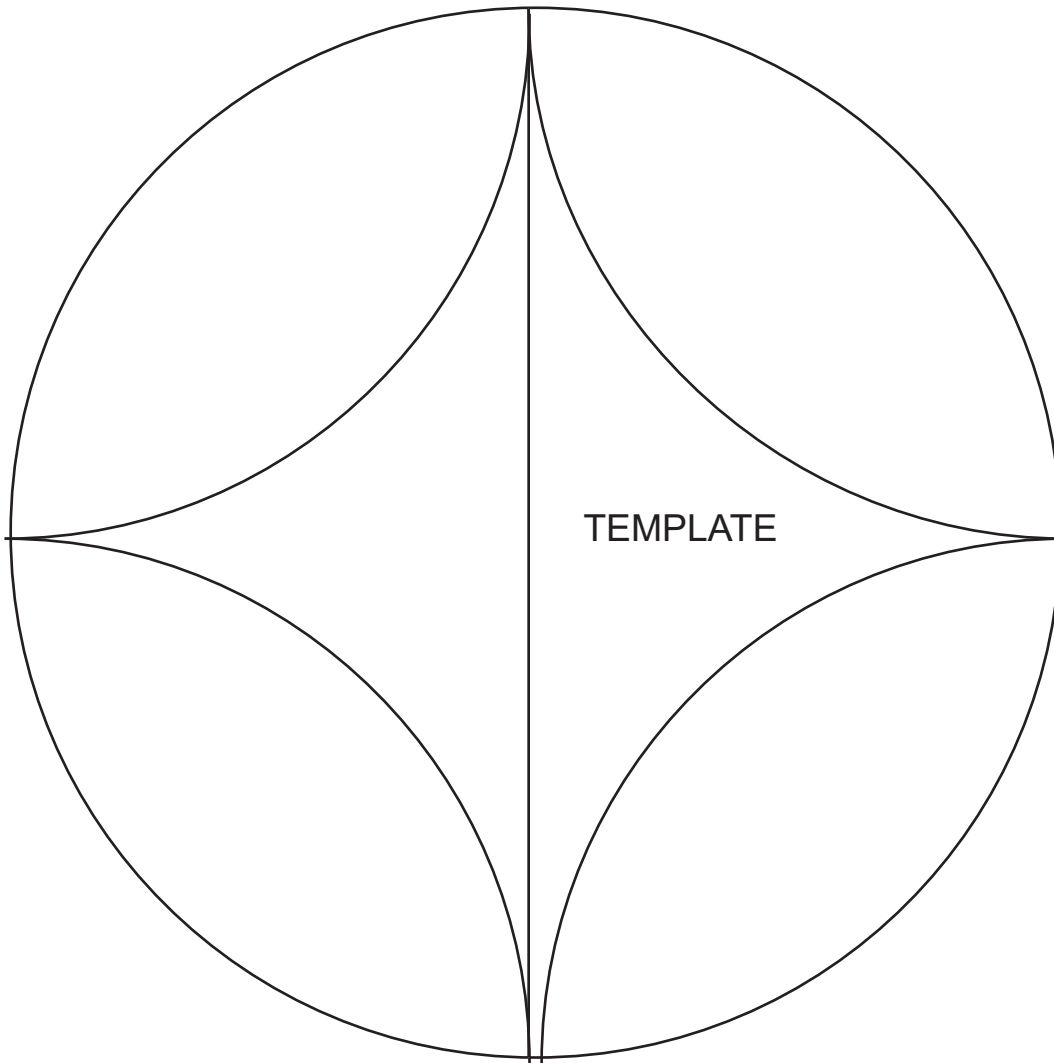
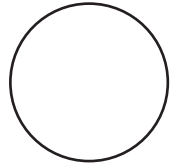


## BUTTERFLY VISITOR TAPESTRY INSTRUCTIONS

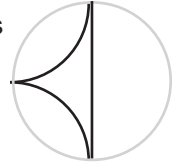
Materials: Floral wire (22 gauge), tissue paper, glue, recycled papers, scissors, small pliers (optional).  
Each child needs three pieces of floral wire.



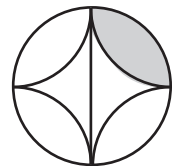
1. First wire makes the circle. Twist ends together.



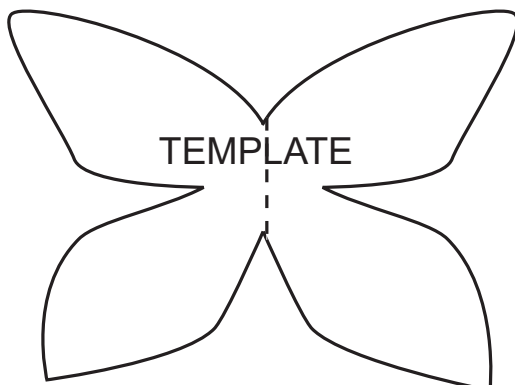
2. Second wire makes the equator line and two scallops.



3. Cut wrappers or paper slightly larger than each scallop/leaf area. Fold over excess paper and glue. Do this for each scallop.



4. Cut out two butterflies of recycled paper and fold down the middle. Sandwich the middle wire between the two butterflies. Glue together.



5. Attach produce netting with wire or string.
